Preservation Trust Fund – Locality Easement Assistance is a reimbursement program. Landowners are responsible for all costs of due diligence (title work, legal services, appraisal, etc.). Reimbursement from the locality is issued to a landowner once an easement records.

Reimbursement Rates

Funds must be disbursed from VOF to a locality. The locality will reimburse the landowner.

Up to \$95,000	100%	All	\$20,000
\$96,000 - \$110,000	75%	All	\$15,000
\$111,000-\$125,000	50%	All	\$10,000
\$125,000-\$200,000	Up to 50%	Survey Work**	\$10,000
Over \$200,000	Not Eligible	N/A	Not Eligible

*Exceptions may be granted for extenuating circumstances.

**If determined by locality staff to be necessary for the protection and stewardship of the conservation project.

While every easement and easement process may be different, there are some standard items that are necessary to have completed in order to put a property under easement. This list contains some of the most common items and their associated cost. As every situation may vary, there may be additional items and costs to be considered. Use this list as a guide.

Examples of Estimated Easement Expenses

Appraisal: \$4,500-\$6,500
Legal Services Including Title Work: \$2,000-\$5,000
Survey*: Lender's Easement & Mortgage Review: \$2,500
Baseline Documentation Report (BDR) Fee: \$3,000-\$3,500
Other Associated Costs Such as Perc Test, Tax Advice

*Include the cost of survey if it is known that one is needed. If the locality determines that a survey is needed, the award amount may be adjusted.
