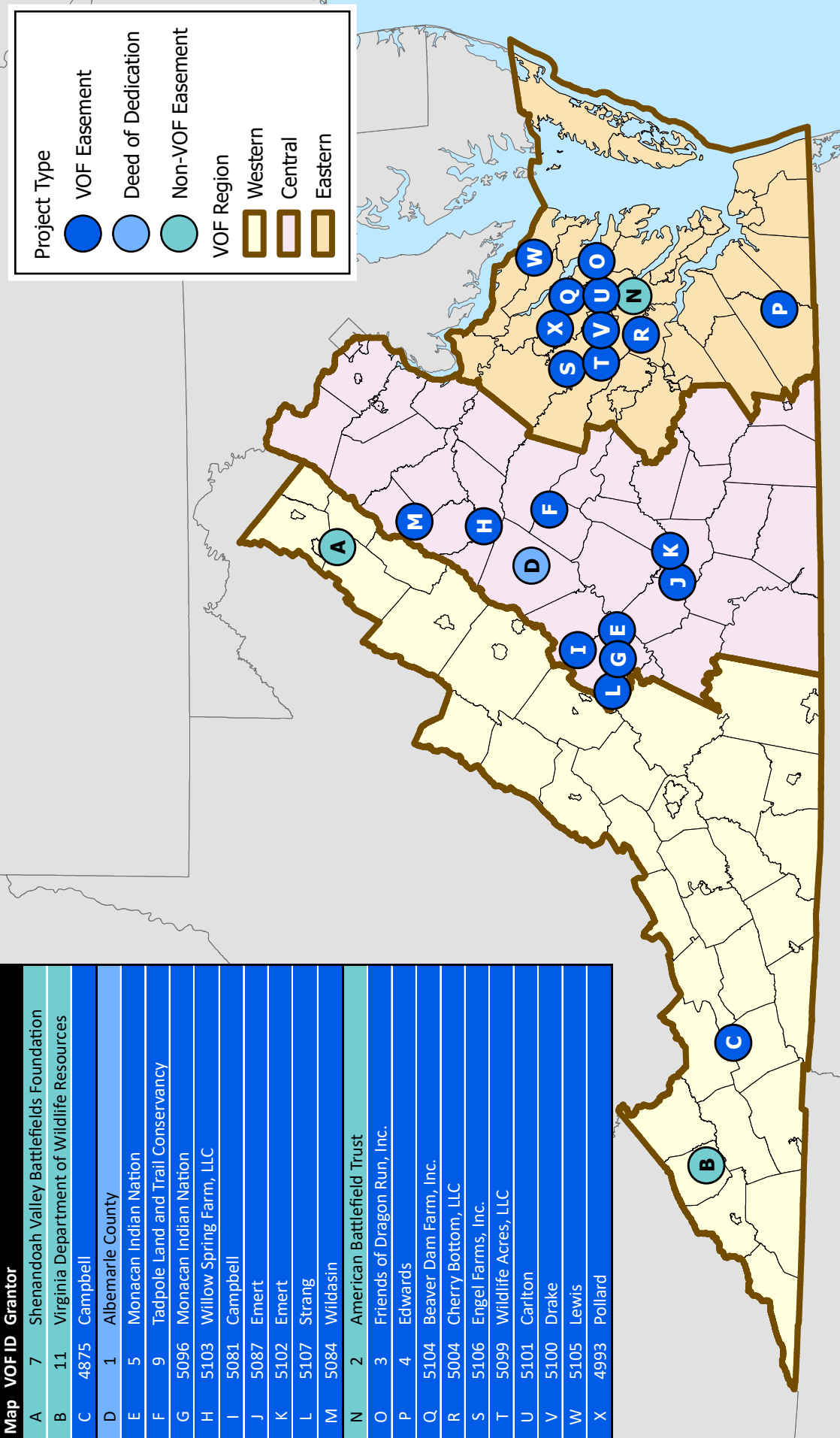

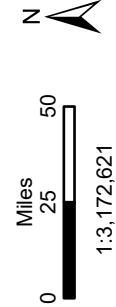

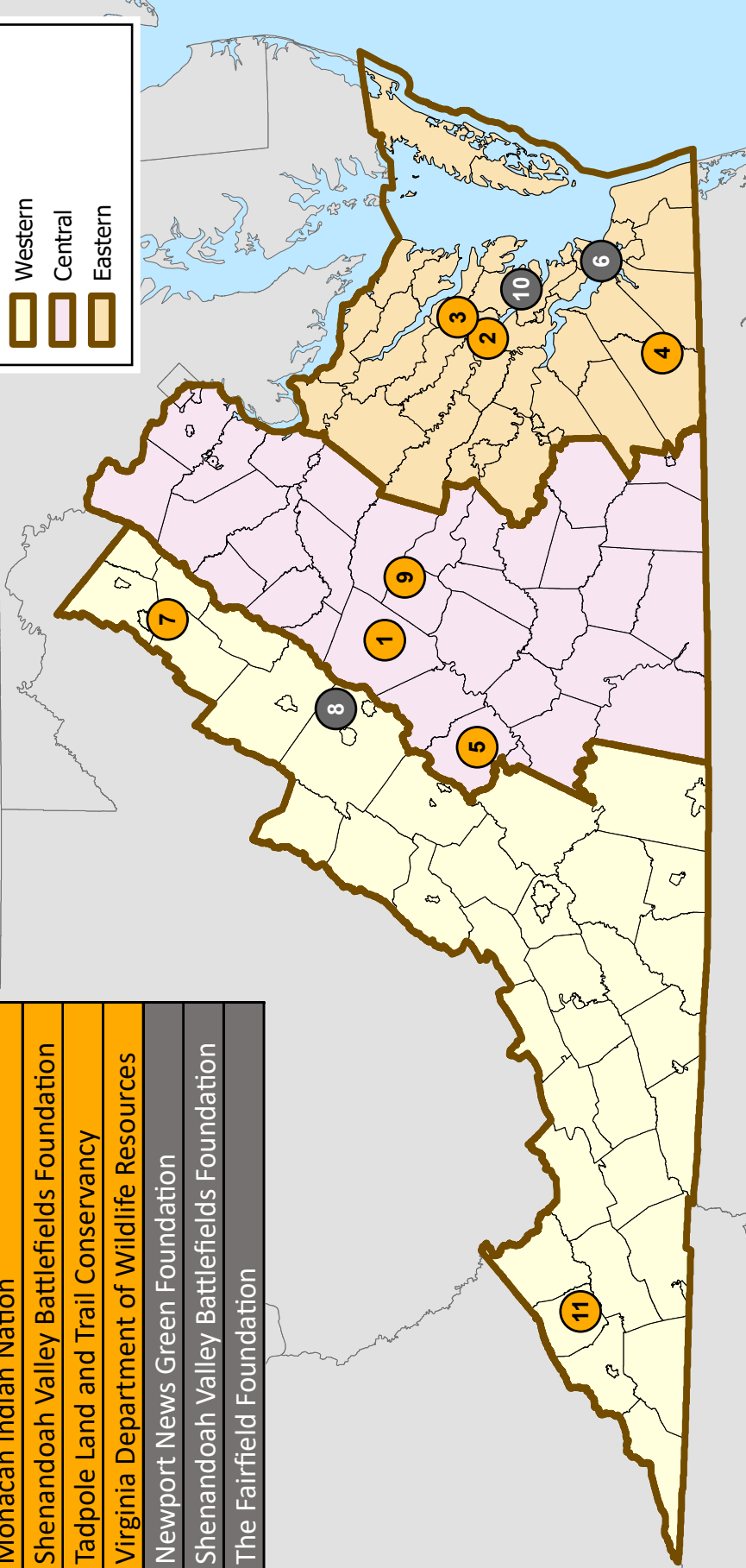

Applicant: 26-01-08 Shenandoah Valley Battlefields Foundation
Project Title: Shiflett II Tract - Piedmont Battlefield
Locality: Augusta County
VOF BOT Region: Western
Funds Requested: \$500,000.00
Description: This proposal is for the purchase of an open space easement to be held by the Virginia Board of Historic Resources. The Shiflett II Tract near New Hope is actively being preserved by the Shenandoah Valley Battlefields Foundation because of its significance to the Piedmont Battlefield (June 5, 1864).

Applicant: 26-01-06 Newport News Green Foundation
Project Title: Sarfan Food Forest
Locality: City of Newport News
VOF BOT Region: Eastern
Funds Requested: \$750,000.00
Description: The Newport News Green Foundation requests funding for the purchase of an open space easement on the Sarfan Food Forest, a project which is transforming a donated five-acre vacant lot in Newport News's Southeast Community into the Peninsula's first, and potentially the U.S.'s third-largest, public edible forest. It will provide free, year-round access to fruit trees, berry patches, vegetables, pollinator meadows, and an outdoor classroom. Designed with community input and support from Virginia Tech, it will enhance food access, ecological health, educational opportunities, and neighborhood vitality.

Applicant: 26-01-10 The Fairfield Foundation
Project Title: Preserving Historic Fairfield's Landscape
Locality: Gloucester County
VOF BOT Region: Eastern
Funds Requested: \$130,000.00
Description: This proposed land acquisition and open space easement project will protect 21.25 acres of land from development and increase the greenway surrounding historic Fairfield manor (built in 1694; DHR Archaeological Site 44GL0024). The Fairfield Foundation, a non-profit, has placed over 240 adjoining acres under easement with the Board of Historic Resources. This parcel adjoins the Fairfield property on the north, bracketing Hickory Fork Road, which is under threat from development.
